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1.0 Overview

MyVector is Total Force Air Force application to support Mentoring, Career Planning and Knowledge Sharing. MyVector allows mentees to manage their career development with the input and guidance from a mentor. Mentees will be able to, in real-time, invite participants to serve as mentors, select mentors based on preferences, chat with their mentor online, and complete a mentoring plan. MyVector also allows the user to view their duty experience through career field specific experience codes. This structure also allows the user to build career plans based on real opportunities and to share these career plans with development teams and mentors. A Bullet-Tracker option allows the user to track specific events and accomplishments throughout the year for Performance Reports. For Knowledge Sharing, the application provides Discussion Forums and links to resources for online books and courses that discuss mentoring benefits, the differences between coaching and mentoring and techniques for managing mentoring relationships. For an overview of all of the above capabilities, the user is referred to the MyVector Individual User Guide. This User Guide is intended for the Report Manager User Role. This Role has all the functionality associated with the Individual User with the additional capabilities to query and view reports.

An Administrator will grant Report Manager Access upon request from the user and coordinated approval from the Career Field Management team.

2.0 Report Manager Dashboard

Report Managers (RMs) will be able to access the Reports and Queries capability of the Career Path Tool via the CPT Management option under their Name at the top right of the screen. Please see Figure 2.0.1.




Figure 2.0-1 – Accessing Career Path Tool for Reports and Queries




Figure 2.0.2 – Career Path Tool Queries Page

Upon selecting the CPT Management option, the user will be able to access the main Queries page in Career Path Tool (Figure 2.0.2). To return to MyVector, the user is able to select the MyVector tab at the top of the page.

3.0 Career Path Tool Queries

In this release there are four categories of queries for the Report Manager: ACM Code, Global ACM, Search for Individual, and ICM Search

3.1 ACM Code

The RM is able to query on one or more Career Fields ACM structure with this option and is the default page for the Report Manager role in Career Path Tool.

The following steps illustrate the use of this query option.

1. Select the Career Type (Officer, Civilian or Enlisted) and all of the associated Career Fields will be displayed.
2. Check the desired Career Field(s) in the Select Career Field(s) box and click on the Display Available ACM Codes button below the box. (this button is not shown in Figure 4.1.1)
 - a. The center of the page populates with the Functional, Org/Spec and Job Codes. There are now three columns of data on the screen. See Figure 4.1.2.




Figure 3.1.1 – ACM Codes populated for Query selection

3. Check the box or boxes within the Available ACM Codes area; the Component (Regular AF, Reserves and/or Air National Guard is available). Note: all Civilian duties are associated to a Civilian component.
4. On the Right side column, the ability to select check the current Grade / Rank of the individual is available
5. The Query can also be narrowed to include only certain Career Fields by choosing from the Select Members' Career Field(s) box. Again, see Figure 3.1-1 for this example.
6. After all parameters are chosen, select Submit Query; to start over, click Clear Parameters. Selected parameters appear in the Criteria Selected for the Query portion of the screen in the top of the right column making it easy to see the results of the choices for the query. Figure 3.1.2 displays the Query for the following: Officer Career Type with experience in the 63A Career Field. Within the 63A Career Field, Space or Nuclear experience in the Functional Area and Group CC equivalent in the Job Area. The component is Regular AF and the current Grade of the individual is Colonel and they are a member of the 62E or 63A Career Field.


The Query selection criterion is displayed at the top of the page. The grid at the bottom of the page contains the names of the members who met the selection criteria of the query. The Export Results to Excel button produces an Excel file which includes the following data elements: Rank/Grade, Last Name, First Name, Middle Initial, Core, Component, Current Duty Title, Current Location, Years and Months of Experience in the select criterion.

ACM Duty SURFs can be generated on any combination of member selections from the resulting report. Clear any of the rows checked by using the Clear Selected Items option.

3.2 Global ACM


Cross-Functional expertise can be assessed by using Global ACM Code association with Career Field-specific ACM Codes. For example, a Nuclear Global ACM Code may be associated with a Nuclear Functional ACM Code in the 63A and 13S Career Fields. The Global ACM page makes this possible; Figure 3.2.1 shows the Global ACM Query page.

Global ACMs have two parts classified as Parent and Child. Figure 3.2.2 illustrates the parent of CYB (for AF Cyber Experience) and the MNT child selected (for Maintenance). To query all CYB experience, the user will only select the Parent code and submit the query. If the user desires to query on Cyber Maintenance experience then they are able to do so by selecting MNT as the Global Specific Code.

If the user desires to have only the members who are currently serving in a duty associated with the specific Global ACM Code then they would check the Current Duties only option.

3.3 Search for Individual




Figure 3.3.1 – Search for Individual Query

The purpose of this query is for users with appropriate roles within CPT to find individual members enrolled in CPT. A duty history or ACM Duty SURF is returned when a member’s name is selected from the query result. If more than one individual meets the search criteria in the Person Search Criteria, a roster of those individuals is displayed. Individuals are selected from that returned pop-up roster. Enter the last name of the individual and click the green check mark image to execute a search. (Figure 3.3.1).

Select the individual by clicking on the last name from the Person Search Results pop-up. (Figure 3.3.2) and the ACM Duty SURF is returned.

At the top of the ACM Duty SURF page (the page that presents the duty summary for the individual searched and selected) there are three buttons;

- **New Individual Search** – returns users to the Search for Individual page
- **Export to PDF** – exports the current user ACM Duty SURF to a .pdf format file
- **Refresh Data** – executes a call to MilPDS on the individual’s duty and refreshes the MilPDS data into CPT

3.4 ICM Search




Figure 3.4.1– ICM Search

An ICM Search – the next menu item in the Queries tab – finds and displays a roster of all persons who are assigned an Individual Capability Management (ICM) Code as reported in CPT. Radio buttons are

available to narrow the search to Global ICM Codes or Career Field ICM Codes. Please see Figure 3.4.1. Submitting a query renders a roster view similar to that shown in Figure 3.1.3 for ACM Code queries.

Selecting an individual name from the pop-up roster launches the ACM Duty SURF on that individual. The ACM Duty SURF can be exported to a .pdf file.

4.0 Reports

All of the reports are accessed via the Reports tab. The reports available include the following:

- Career Field by Functional Duty – Returns a matrix of all members currently belonging to the Career Field CORE ID by their current Duty AFSC and functional Digit ACM Code associated with the duty.
- Duty Code by Functional ACM – Returns a matrix of members currently serving in a Career Field Duty AFSC by the functional Digit ACM Code associated with the duty regardless of the individual’s current Career Field.
- Duty Code by Org/Specialty ACM– Returns a matrix of all those currently serving in a Career Field Duty AFSC by the Org/Experience ACM Code associated with the duty regardless of the current Career Field.
- ACM Summary by Career Field– Returns a summary of the Career Fields ACM Summary for the 4th, 5th and 6th digits
- ICM Summary – Returns the name of all of the ICM Codes along with their description and the associated Career Fields/Components.
- Officer Year Group– Displays the officers that belong to the selected Year Group.
- Roster by Grade– This report displays the members that belong to the selected rank or grade within selected Career Field(s).

4.1 Career Field by Functional Duty

The Career Field by Functional Duty report landing page displays the aggregate totals by grade for the Functional ACM Code assignment for the duties of the members belonging to the selected Career Field. Figure 4.1.1 demonstrates the outcome when 14N – Intelligence is selected and the resultant current duties being served by Core 14N officers. Clicking on any non-zero field will navigate away from this page to the appropriate ACM query.

Filters can be applied to restrict the view by Component or specific Career Field ACM Code. Report fidelity can be fine-tuned by selecting a linked number which provides a roster of individuals serving in a selected category.

The Report Manager is able to export the matrix to an Excel file by selecting the Export to Excel option at the top of the page.

4.2 Duty Code by Functional ACM

This report displays the aggregate totals by grade for the Functional ACM Code assignment for the members currently serving in duties belonging to the selected Career Field. Selecting a career field returns a matrix showing the distribution of the Career Field. Clicking on any non-zero field will navigate away from this page to display a roster of the members currently serving in that specific ACM Code.

Limit the display to any combination of the 3 components by using the checkboxes available beneath the Career Field Selection area. The information can be exported to an Excel file by selecting the Export to Excel option at the top of the page.

4.3 Duty Code by Org/Specialty ACM

This report displays the aggregate totals by grade for the Org/Specialty ACM Code assignment for the selected Career Field. Selecting a career field results in a matrix output showing the distribution of that Career Field. Clicking on any non-zero field will navigate away from this page to display a roster of those individuals currently serving in that specific ACM Code.

The Report Manager is able to limit the display to any combination of the 3 components displayed by using the checkboxes available beneath the Career Field Selection area. The Report Manager is able to export the matrix to an Excel file by selecting the Export to Excel option at the top of the page.

4.4 ACM Summary by Career Field




Figure 4.4.1– ACM Summary by Career Field

This report displays all of the ACM Codes created for the selected career field (Figure 4.4.1).

4.5 ICM Summary

This report displays all of the created ICM Codes in the Career Path Tool. The Report includes attributes of the ICM Code to include the following:

- The ICM Code itself
- A description of the ICM Code.
- Indicates if the ICM Code is visible to the individual user when they view their ACM brief.
- The Officer Career Fields the ICM is available to (Global means all)
- The Civilian Career Fields the ICM is available to (Global means all)
- The Enlisted Career Fields the ICM is available to (Global means all)

4.6 Officer Year Group

This report displays the officers that belong to the selected Year Group. Choose a Career Field from the list on the right in Figure 4.6.1. This will populate the drop down menu with the appropriate Year Groups from which you may select. Once both parameters are chosen, you may submit the query. Displayed with their names is the highest level of education and their highest PME. Their current duty title and location is also displayed. The results of the report can be exported to Excel by clicking the appropriate button. You may also view any officers Duty SURF by clicking on their Last Name in the results grid.

4.7 Roster by Grade

This report displays the members that belong to the selected rank or grade. Choose a Career Field from the list on the right in Figure 4.7.1. This will populate the drop down menu with the appropriate grades. After both Career Field and Rank/Grade are chosen, submit the query. The results of the report can be exported to Excel. Any member's Duty SURF is available by clicking on the Last Name in the results grid.




Figure 5.0.1 – Individual Search

The RM will be able to execute an individual query in MyVector by utilizing the dropdown menu option (See figure 5.0.1)
